

Daniel: A Prototype of the Mature Church



14 Even if these three men, <u>Noah, Daniel, and Job</u>, were in it, they would deliver but their own lives by <u>their righteousness</u>, declares the Lord GOD...16 even if these three men were in it, as I live, declares the Lord GOD, they would deliver neither sons nor daughters. We have to pay attention to the book and life of Daniel

Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego answered and said to the king, "O Nebuchadnezzar, we have no need to answer you in this matter. 17 If this be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of your hand, O king.18 But if not, be it known to you, O king, that we will not serve your gods or worship

the golden image that you have set up."

19 Then Nebuchadnezzar was filled with fury, and the expression of his face was changed against Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. He ordered the furnace heated seven times more than it was usually heated. 20 And he ordered some of the mighty men of his army to bind Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, and to cast them into the burning fiery furnace. 21 Then these men were bound in their cloaks, their tunics, their hats, and their other garments, and they were thrown into the burning fiery furnace.


The Main Message of Daniel – Jesus Christ and His Church

When I came to you, I did not come with eloquence or human wisdom as I proclaimed to you the testimony about God. For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ and him crucified. (1 Cor 2:1-2)

To me, though I am the very least of all the saints, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ, and to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God, who created all things, so that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places. This was according to the eternal purpose that he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord, in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through our faith in him. (Eph 3:8–11)

Daniel is a prototype for the end time church unlike any other in scripture

1. He lived through a prototype of the end of the age. 2. He lived through a delay in the fulfilment of God's promises. 3. He was identified as one of the greatest intercessors in history. 4. He was identified as one of the wisest human beings. 5. He was told repeatedly he was dearly loved in heaven. 6. His prayers moved God to give him insight and set in motion heavenly conflict. 7. There are no flaws in the way he was presented in Scripture



Chapter 1: Daniel's resolve to trust God leads to understanding

Chapter 1 depicts a remnant who trust in what God has said more than their own physical senses.

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction. (Prov 1:7)

Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. (Prov 3:4)

They pass the test of the Garden of Eden.

Who will raise a company of Daniels - ones who know and trust God - in our generation?

Chapter 2: Anchoring on the Eternal Kingdom

Chapter 2 reveals the hope of the eternal kingdom that anchors our faith

Pattern of the vision:

- Gold (current; Babylon)
- Silver (to come within Daniel's lifetime; Medo-Persian)
- Bronze (to come after Daniel's lifetime; Greek)
- Iron, with part clay (future last human kingdom)
- Stone (eternal kingdom of God)

Daniel's visions are all centered on the culmination of the eternal kingdom of God. His later visions (Dan 7, 8, 9, 11-12) all expound on this foundation.

Chapter 3: The central issue is worship

Chapter 3 is not about how the righteous will be rewarded with success/influence. Rather, it is about the resolve to worship even when everything in Babylon resists it.

Twice in the book Daniel/friends are threatened with death:

- Dan 3: thrown in the fiery furnace over worship
- Dan 6: thrown in the lions' den over prayer


Their response is profound: God is able to deliver us from the fiery furnace, but we will remain faithful unto death even if he doesn't.

Twice more, the book of Daniel predicts a people who will stand firm in persecution:

- Dan 8: God delivers his people from the antichrist
- Dan 11:32–35: God's people resist the antichrist even under intense pressure
