
PART 2: WHERE ARE YOUR ACCUSERS?

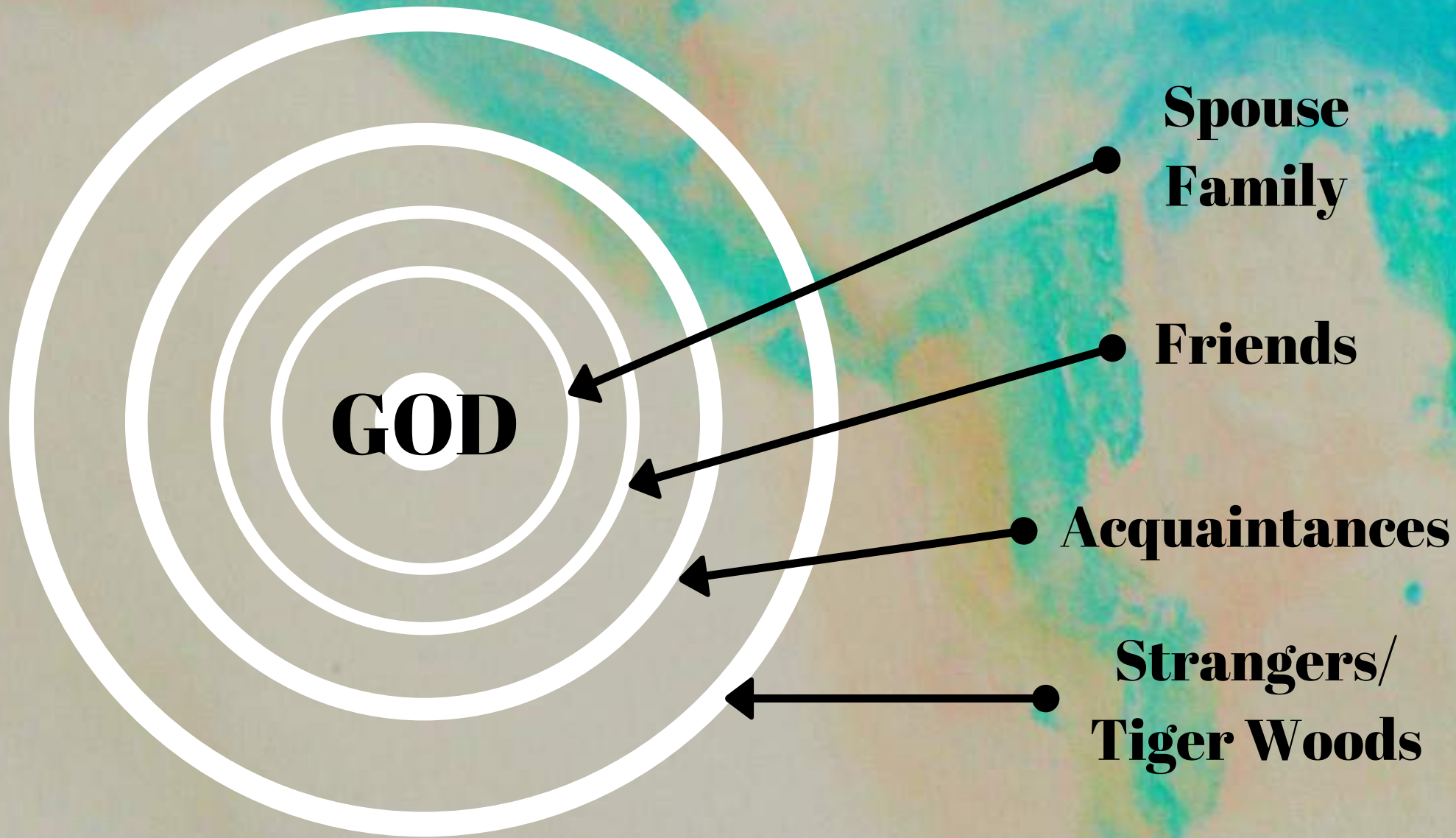
